Pete works with other Bay Area sustainable farms to bring us organic produce. All the farms he sources from don't use any GMOs, synthetic fertilizers, pesticides or herbicides.

How do I order and pay?

Come once a month, every other week, or whatever works best for your family. Consider sharing an order with a friend or neighbor to try it. Once you RSVP you are responsible for payment even if you forget to pick-up, rain or shine.

How much does it cost?

The cost for an order of fresh, local, sustainable, organic produce is **\$25 cash** and will consist of seasonal vegetables and fruits. Also, Pete generously donates \$2 from each order to support the LASD Living Classroom program. Such a benefit!

On Thursdays from 2:30 – 5pm, Pete will come to Springer with his white van and be out in front of the lower grade lunch area. Come share recipe ideas with other parents, and fill your bags with fresh produce.
